Louis Coleman Hall served as Secretary of AUTONOMY until recently, but he remains on the Board. He has been active with ADAPT, Chicago, where he worked on transit issues, and he participated in the national disability rally in Washington, D.C. to enact the ADA in 1990. He has served on the Board of the Oregon Paralyzed Veterans of America (OPVA), and has served as coordinator of volunteers of the OPVA's homeless veterans project. He also organized and coordinated the Sixth Anniversary Celebration of the ADA in Portland, Oregon in 1996. Louis, who sustained a spinal injury in 1979, has paraplegia and resides in Oregon.
